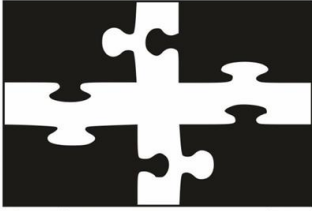
Other business

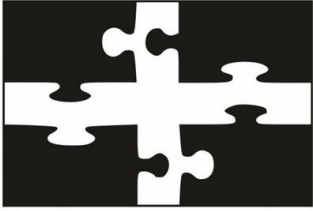
