

Assessment and Care Plans

Stuart Cohen said Cornwall People First must give a lot more detail about the problems with assessments and care.

Shelagh Mitchell said small care plans take a long time sort out and needs increase.

Tina Sanford of Adult Social Care said staff do check people are Ok whilst they wait



The council needs more support workers.



The 1st meeting with the support worker should be good as it is so important



Sarah Picking said social workers could refer people to advocates who will speak for them.



Safety where you live is important.

- Plans should be discussed with police.
- Stuart will invite Home Choice to attend a meeting.
- Devon and Cornwall Police will try to help if Cornwall People First can give more information about hate crimes



Stuart Cohen will ask Day Services what distance day service clients can travel to get to their activities.
