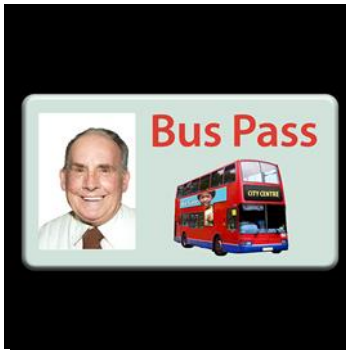
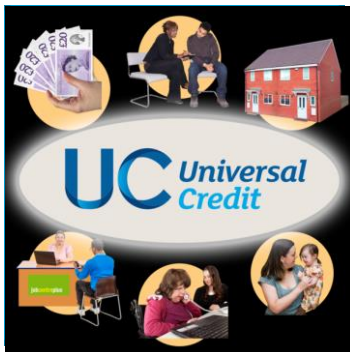


Learning Disability Partnership Board meeting 14 March 2018
